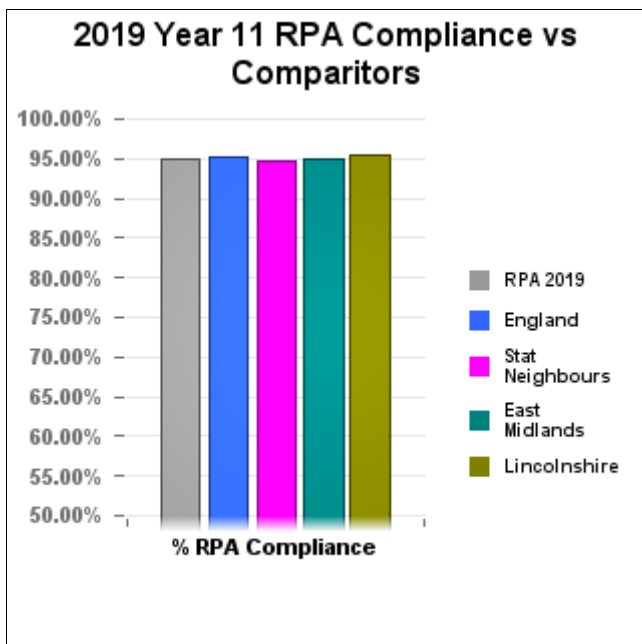

Raising the Participation Age

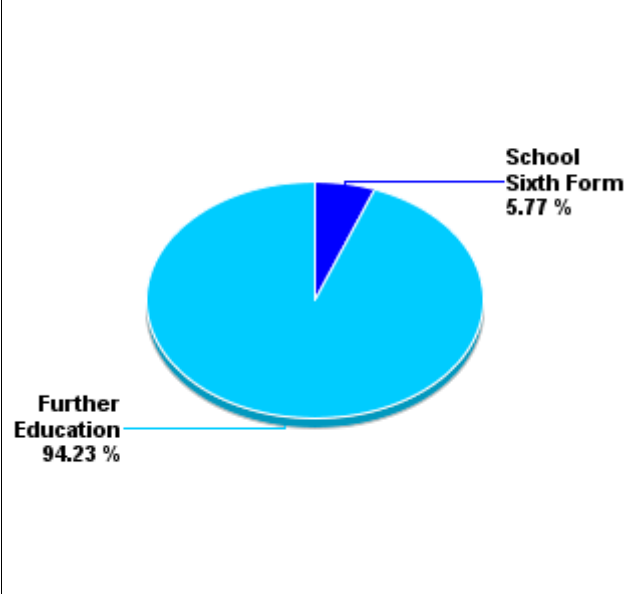

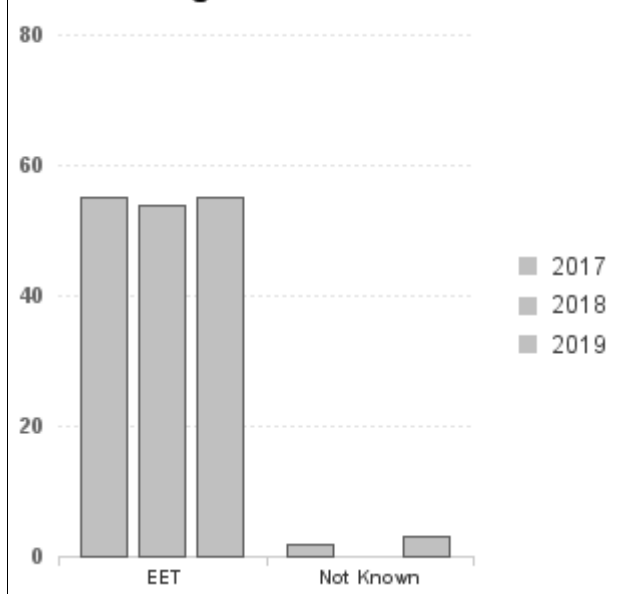

Employment without training	Employees in a job that does not provide any training leading to qualifications
Not Known	A young person with a situation not currently known by the local authority.
